## PLEASE BE AWARE!!

### PIPES CAN FREEZE AT 10° OR COLDER

The City of Kimball suggests that you leave a small stream of cold water running:

- At night;
- When you will be gone for an extended time, or
- When no water is being used

When it is 10° or colder, a stream about the size of a pencil lead should be enough to keep a pipe from freezing and bursting

A new water meter is the customer's responsibility and repairs can cost you \$\$\$.

### 94.50 Requirement to Keep Clean

It shall be unlawful for the occupant of any lot or lots or the owner of any vacant lot or lots within the corporate limits to allow snow, sleet, mud, ice, or other substance to accumulate on the sidewalks or to permit any snow, sleet, mud, ice or other substance to remain upon the sidewalk. Unless the City Council has provided otherwise, all sidewalks within the business district shall be cleaned within 5 hours after the cessation of a storm, unless the storm or fall of snow shall have taken place during the night, in which case, the sidewalk shall be cleaned before 9:00 AM the following day. Sidewalks within the residential areas of the city shall be cleaned within 24 hours after the cessation of the storm.

**DON'T FORGET:** Budget Billing is available this month only. You must have lived in your current residence for a minimum of 1 year. If you are interested, stop down to the City Offices and fill out the form by December 31.

### Just a Reminder . . .

#### Severe Weather Suspension of Disconnection

The City of Kimball will suspend disconnection of service due to non-payment to all residential customers under the following weather conditions:

- Winter – Disconnection is suspended any time the average temperature for the next 24 or 48 hours is forecasted to be 32 degrees or below
- Summer – Disconnection is suspended any time the average heat index is forecasted to be 105 degrees or higher at any point during the next 24 or 48 hour period.

A weather related late fee of \$80.26 will be assessed.
